

On Target! School Program 2022

Welcome to a new year of offerings from the third largest Archery Club, Arrogone Archers. What we lack in facilities, we make up for in strong inclusion initiatives, love of the sport and the desire to bring archery to as many people as possible.

After crunching the numbers and looking at what was well received in our spring and summer holiday programs, we've put together a number of enticing options for your schools and department. We also acknowledge that some schools have found the previous offerings from us and other clubs too expensive. We've taken that into consideration, because we truly want such an accessible sport to be enjoyed by as many people as possible.

Our usual fee for a single session of 20 students is about \$300. This session normally ran between 1.5 to 2 hours, however we are taking price into consideration to make it more accessible for schools, so for some commitment we've put together the following with a reduced session length of 1-1.5 hours:

- **Double**/Two sessions (back-to back on a single day) - \$500 (\$250 per session. 16.7% saving)

- **Triple**/Three sessions (back-to-back on a single day) - \$600 (\$200 per session. 33% saving)

For us, having the sessions held on a single day allows for us to reduce the set-up and pack up times on a per session basis and ensures that running sessions is viable for our instructor. Any gaps between the sessions on a day can be discussed and we can talk about more sessions in a day if it fits with the school's timetable.

We also have some extended offerings for schools/department that want to commit to more classes in a term or during the year:

Four Single Sessions (One per day. 4 sessions total) - \$960 (\$240 per session. 20% saving)

Four Double Sessions (One double per day. 8 sessions total) - \$1600 (\$200 per session. 33% saving)

Four Triple Sessions (One Triple per day. 12 sessions total) - \$1920 (\$160 per session. 46.7% saving)

In all of these offerings we are willing to offer the discounts outside of a per school basis. E.g if School A, School B and School C booked sessions on the one day, then they would each be charged the **Triple** rate of \$200 per session. The same can be said for the extended sessions as well. We are also more than willing to discuss and negotiate other options with the schools and education department. We would also be quite willing to enter into a longer term partnership.

We are trying to source external support for the club in the form of sponsorship and in the future we may be able to reduce the costs further.

The session plans will vary depending on whether we have classes attending one or multiple sessions. I have some ideas depending on which option you would be interested in.

Lastly, just a little bit of information about our field:

- We are located on the Gerrard Street Reserve in Moonah.
- We do not currently have access to toilets. There are some nearby at the John Turnbull park
- We do not have access to large undercover shelter, so sessions may need to be postponed if the forecast is grim.
- We unfortunately do not have wheelchair access due the current state of the field.
- We do not currently have the capability to bring targets and equipment to schools. This would also involve an increase in set up and pack up time should we look into it in the future.

We are trying to address some of the above issues; however, many solutions are both long term and outside our current budget.
